

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Notice governs the manner in which Stirred Health Ltd, collects, uses, maintains and discloses information collected from users (each, a “User”) of the www.stirredhealth.co.uk website (“Site”). This Privacy Notice came into effect as of 09 June 2021. Stirred Health Ltd, is committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected. Should we ask you to provide certain information by which you can be identified when using this website, then you can be assured that it will only be used in accordance with this privacy statement.

This policy explains when and why we collect personal information about people who visit our website and how we use it, the conditions under which we may disclose it to others and how we keep it secure.

By visiting or using our website, to the extent permitted by applicable law, you are consenting to us gathering and processing information about you in accordance with this Policy, although consent may not be required for all elements described in this policy. For particular types of information or processing, we may provide you with choices or request your further consent related to what information we collect and how we may process it.

Data Controller

Personal identification information

This privacy policy applies to the Site and all products and services offered by Stirred Health Ltd. We may collect and process the following data from you:

- If you contact us, we may keep a record of that correspondence
- Purchase our services
- Subscribe to a newsletter
- Respond to a survey
- Fill out our Contact Us Form
- By the use of cookies on our site (see description of cookies below)

If you provide us with personal data about a third party (for example when registering a domain on their behalf), you warrant that you have obtained the express consent from the third party for the disclosure and use of their personal data.

The personal data that we may collect from you includes your name, address, email address, phone numbers, payment information and IP addresses only if users voluntarily submit such information to us.

We may also keep details of your visits to our site including, but not limited to traffic data, location data, and other communication data. Users may, however, visit our Site anonymously.

Users can always refuse to supply personally identification information, except that it may prevent them from engaging in certain Site related activities.

Non-personal identification information

We may collect non-personal identification information about Users whenever they interact with our Site. Non-personal identification information may include the browser name, generic local location, the type of computer and technical information about Users means of connection to our Site, such as the operating system and the Internet service providers utilized and other similar information.

Web browser cookies

Our Site may use “cookies” (small text files that are placed on your machine to help the site provide a better user experience) to enhance User experience. User’s web browser places cookies on their hard drive for record-keeping purposes and sometimes to track information about them. In general, cookies are used to retain user preferences and provide anonymised tracking data to third party applications like Google Analytics. Users may choose to set their web browser to refuse cookies, or to alert you when cookies are being sent. If they do so, note that some parts of the Site may not function properly.

How we use collected information

We may use information about you in the following ways:

- To process orders that you have submitted to us;
- To provide you with products and services that you have ordered;
- To comply with our contractual obligations we have with you;
- To help us identify you and any accounts you hold with us;
- To enable us to review, develop and improve the website and services;
- To provide customer care, including responding to your requests if you contact us with a query;
- To administer accounts, process payments and keep track of billing and payments;
- To review job applications;
- To inform you of service and price changes.
- To improve customer service Information you provide, helps us respond to your customer service requests and support needs more efficiently.
- To personalise user experience. We may use information in the aggregate to understand how our Users as a group use the services and resources provided on our Site.
- To send periodic emails If Users decide to opt-in to our mailing list, they will receive emails that may include company news, updates, related product or service information, etc. If at any time the User would like to unsubscribe from receiving

future emails, we include detailed unsubscribe instructions at the bottom of each email or User may contact us via our Site.

How we protect your information

We adopt appropriate data collection, storage and processing practices and security measures to protect against unauthorized access, alteration, disclosure or destruction of your personal information, username, password, transaction information and data stored on our Site.

Sharing your personal information

We do not sell, trade, or rent Users personal identification information to others. We may share generic aggregated demographic information not linked to any personal identification information regarding visitors and users with our business partners, trusted affiliates and advertisers for the purposes outlined above. Third party websites Users may find advertising or other content on our Site that link to the sites and services of our partners, suppliers, advertisers, sponsors, licensors and other third parties. We do not control the content or links that appear on these sites and are not responsible for the practices employed by websites linked to or from our Site. Browsing and interaction on any other website, including websites which have a link to our Site, is subject to that website's own terms and policies.
